

### Two-Volume VRI Title with 20% Discount

One of the VRI titles that was included in the above-mentioned shipment is [The Buddha as Depicted in the Tipiṭaka](#) (Volume 1 & 2).

Our late Vipassana Teacher S.N. Goenka faced some initial hesitation before joining his first Vipassana course as he'd experienced indoctrination against the Buddha's teachings during his childhood. After his first course in 1955, the misconceptions that he had about the Buddha's teaching were dispelled and he was inspired to study the words of the Buddha in the Pāli language.



[Goenkaji](#) subsequently wrote a comprehensive introduction to the Tipiṭaka incorporating quotes, inspiring passages from the Tipiṭaka, and interesting incidents from the Buddha's life.

In his words: "The Tipiṭaka is like a vast, captivating garden containing beautiful flowers of different hues and fragrances. I have plucked a few flowers from that garden and have woven them into a garland. This jeweled ornament has been fashioned by culling a few priceless gems from the vast ocean of the Dhamma."


## Children Section Restocked



## Residential Pāli Workshops



Pariyatti has been facilitating [residential Pāli workshops](#) for Vipassana meditators in our traditions since 2012—in the USA and in Colombia, Costa Rica, Chile, Israel, Malaysia, Mexico, Morocco, Poland, and Spain.

The aim of these workshops is to provide greater access to the words of the Buddha, which will enable a deeper understanding of the Buddha's teaching, the Dhamma. Goenkaji has emphasized that Pāli workshops such as these are very beneficial: they help meditators develop inspiration and understanding of the theoretical aspect of Dhamma. These workshops cannot take place at a Vipassana center, as centers are dedicated to the practice of Vipassana only. Therefore, a suitable off-center location is arranged for each course.

Two new workshops have been added to the calendar. In November of this year Klaus Nothnagel will give an introductory workshop in California; Adriana Patiño will conduct another introductory workshop in Malaysia in April next year.



Participants from the most recent Pāli workshop in Temecula by Adriana found that the course offered a good "balance of grammar and chanting." One participant mentioned they liked the approach of the course, it being a "combination of learning a bit of history, some grammar, as well as chanting, and the suttas—and how those tie together with the practice."



Another participant mentioned that the course incorporated "the kind of stuff that is hard to find out, by just looking up the words in a dictionary," such as "learning the roots of the words in Pāli (breaking down the word and dissecting a word from its combinations)." In the feedback participants mentioned as well that they'd found the sutta analysis (and word-by-word Pāli translation) very valuable, to learn the stories behind the suttas (and chantings).

Several participants agreed that learning to chant with the base of anicca and with understanding of the words really strengthens one's own practice, and with that, brings benefits to others.



Pariyatti Editions are quality prints with an ergonomic page size, an easy-to-read font, and a sturdy spine.






