
## New Pariyatti Release:

### Manual of Pāli Grammar Book—Hardback

We are happy to announce that the first volume of the three-volume set *Manual of Pāli Grammar* is now available as a hardback Pariyatti Edition!

A comprehensively detailed explanation of Pāli grammar, the manual is free from unnecessary technical jargon.

It simplifies the complexity of grammar through a systematic classification of Pāli nouns. It is intended to be used alongside Kaccāyana's Pāli Grammar (English translation), suitable for serious students.



#### Order Book A

**Book A** of the first volume explains core grammatical concepts, morphological procedures and their uses, as well as various noun groups and their structural stages of change. It aids in developing both word-building skills and fundamental knowledge about the structural dynamics of words, crucial to successfully learning Pāli. The role of morphological rules are elucidated by means of the relevant sutta examples for each noun based on the gender, noun ending, and specific case-endings in each lesson.

**Book B** of the first volume is a practical Pāli reader with simple sentences composed of various nouns studied in Book A, with additional helpful notes and explanations. It aids in developing practical reading and comprehension skills.





## Residential Pāli Workshops




Pariyatti facilitates **residential Pāli workshops** with the aim to provide greater access to the words of the Buddha, enabling a deeper understanding of the Dhamma. Goenkaji emphasized that Pāli workshops are very beneficial: they help meditators develop understanding of the theoretical aspect of Dhamma and inspiration for their practice. Pāli workshops cannot take place at a Vipassana center, as centers are dedicated to the practice of Vipassana only. Therefore, a suitable off-center location is arranged for each course.

The first upcoming workshop (November, in Temecula, California) will be taught by Klaus Nothnagel. In Klaus' workshops, participants receive an introduction to Pāli grammar, and then spend the majority of their time reading and translating suttas and some of the ten-day morning chantings from the Vipassana courses in our tradition. Participants also learn the proper pronunciation.

The workshop will be held at a private luxury ranch in Temecula, California. Accommodation is dormitory style with shared bathrooms. Tents are available on site if you require private accommodations.

The Global Vipassana Pagoda in Mumbai was built to mark the birth centenary year of Sayagyi U Ba Khin, Burmese Dhamma father and Vipassana Teacher of our late Teacher S.N. Goenka. Built in the style of the Shwedagon pagoda in Yangon, the Mumbai monument is a token of gratitude to Myanmar—where the essence of the Buddha's teachings was maintained in its pristine purity, and from where it has been spreading throughout India and the rest of the world.

Goenkaji was the vehicle for the worldwide spread as well as the inspiring guide for every important aspect of this building project of the pagoda. Tremendous volition and effort went into the building of the architectural marvel: *The Jewel in Mumbai* (in Hindi) is the story of the crystal bud atop it, as chronicled by mediator-jeweler Bikram Dandia. The story includes wonderful 'miracles', or rather, examples that show that Dhamma works; that mediators no doubt will find inspiring.

The trouble is that too much praise, particularly if it borders on flattery, stimulates the sense of "I"-ness.
