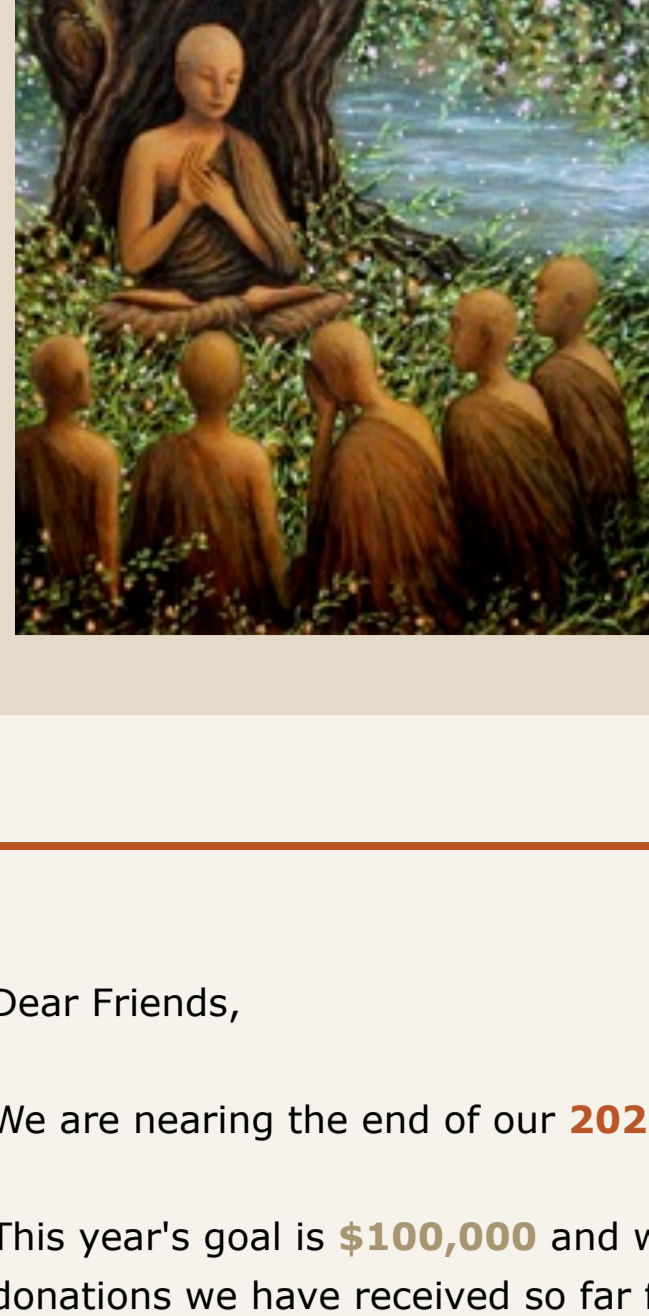
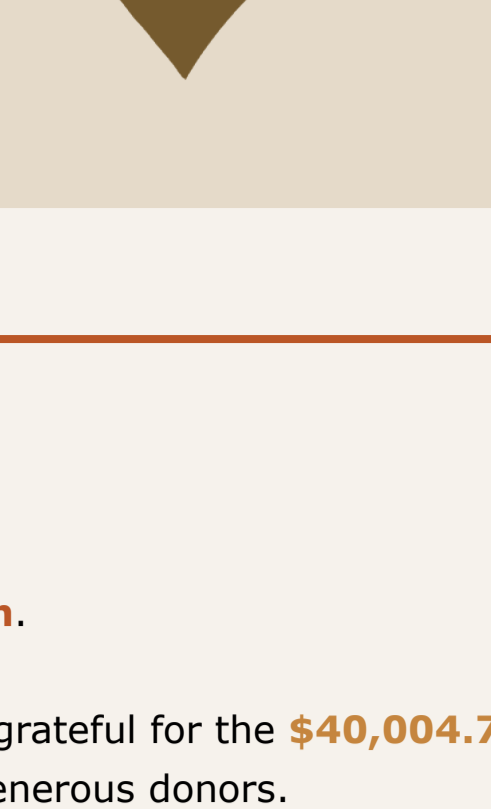

May you all experience peace and harmony in 2026. May more and more people find the path to liberation, walk on it, and grow in Dhamma...

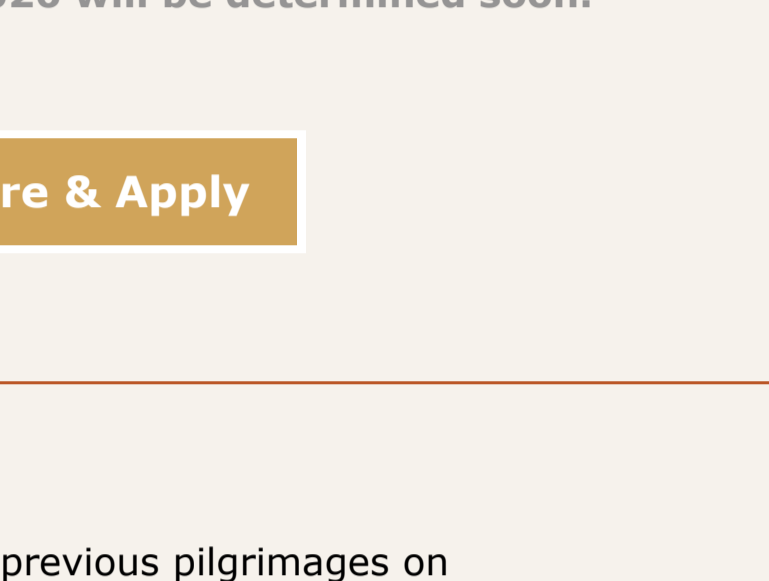
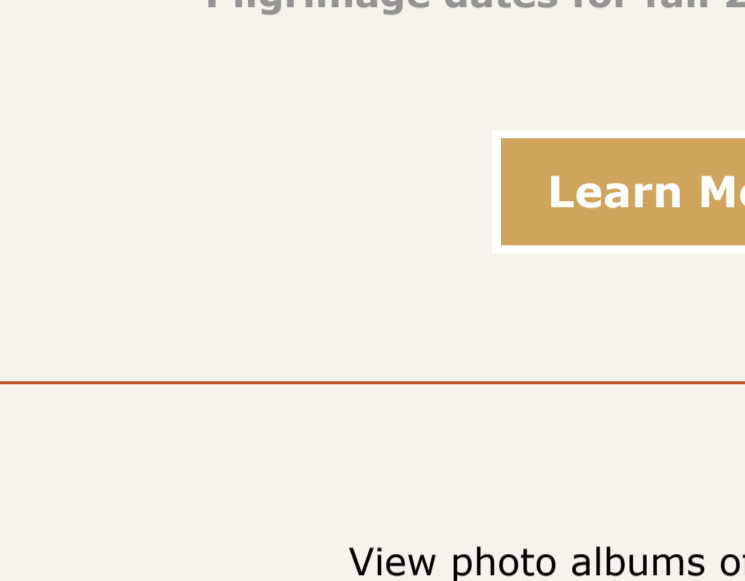

Pilgrimages for Vipassana Meditators



Since Pariyatti launched its Vipassana pilgrimage program in 2013, we have facilitated 36 pilgrimages, offering more than 800 Vipassana meditators in the tradition of S.N. Goenka the opportunity to travel to places connected with the teachings of the Buddha and his followers, and to meditate at those sites together with Dhamma friends from the same tradition.

The primary pilgrimage we offer is called [Along the Path \(ATP\)](#), and its itinerary includes 'site-sitting' (visiting and meditating at) the main four places related to the life and teaching of the Buddha: his birthplace (Lumbini, Nepal), the place where he attained Enlightenment (Bodhgaya, India), the place where he first taught the way to Enlightenment (Sarnath, India), and the place where he attained parinibbana (Kushinagar, India).

We also offer occasional other itineraries; since 2013 we have facilitated seven pilgrimages to the *Golden Land* (Burma/Myanmar), but due to the military coup in February 2021 and the subsequent social, political, and economic turmoil, that itinerary is now on hold.

In 2025 we offered for the second time since 2017 a pilgrimage *Off the Beaten Path*, exploring rarely visited sites in the vicinity of Bodhgaya and Rajgir in India, where the Dhamma flourished from the 3rd Century BCE to the 10th Century AD.

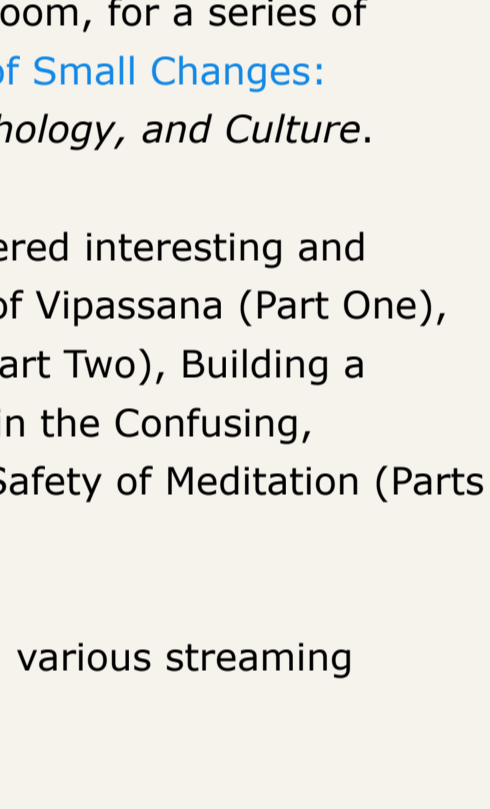
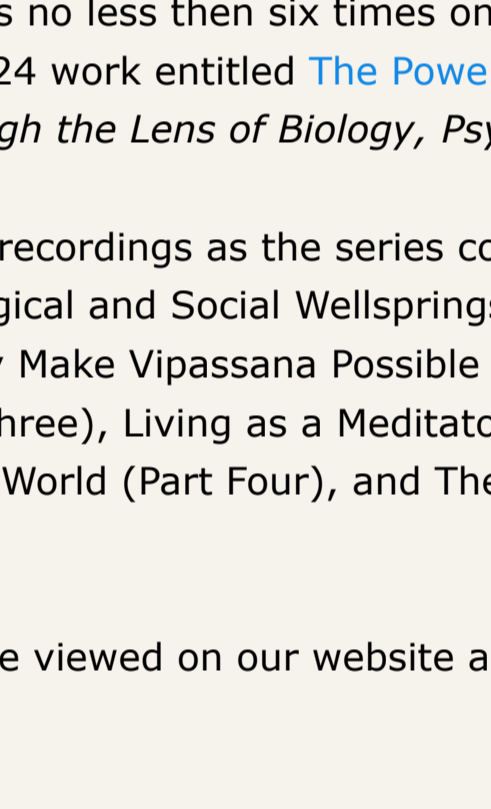
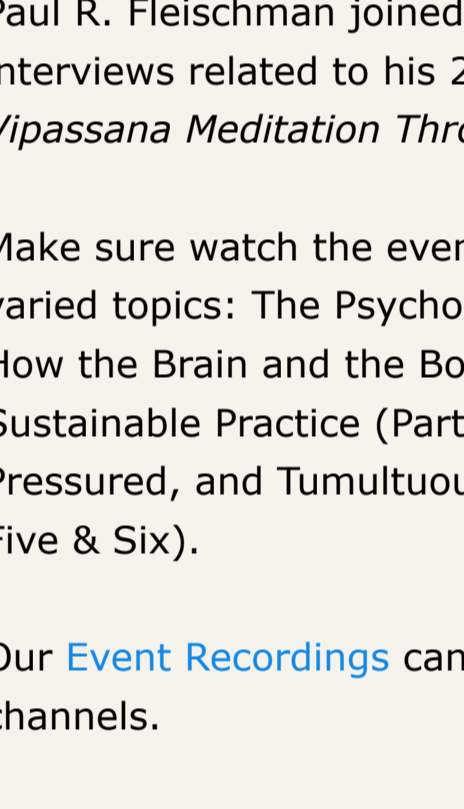
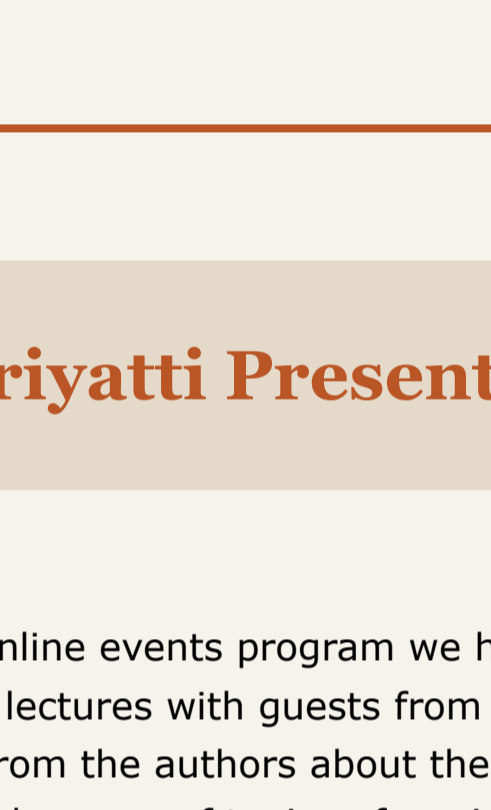
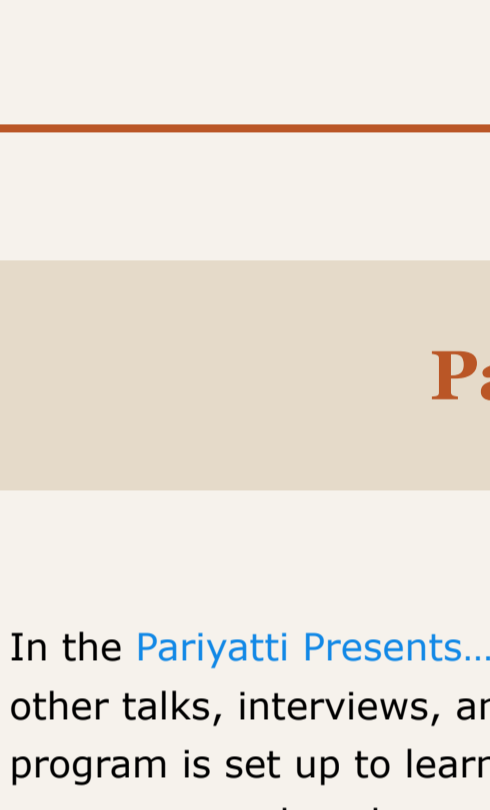

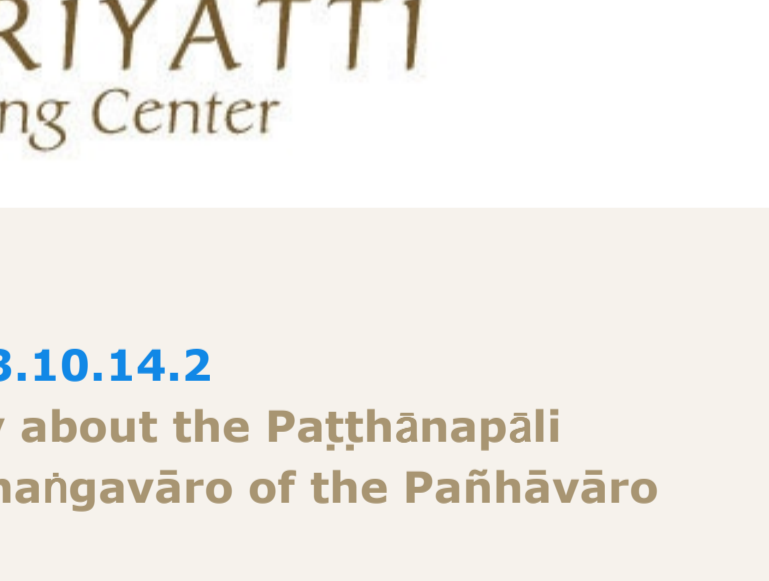
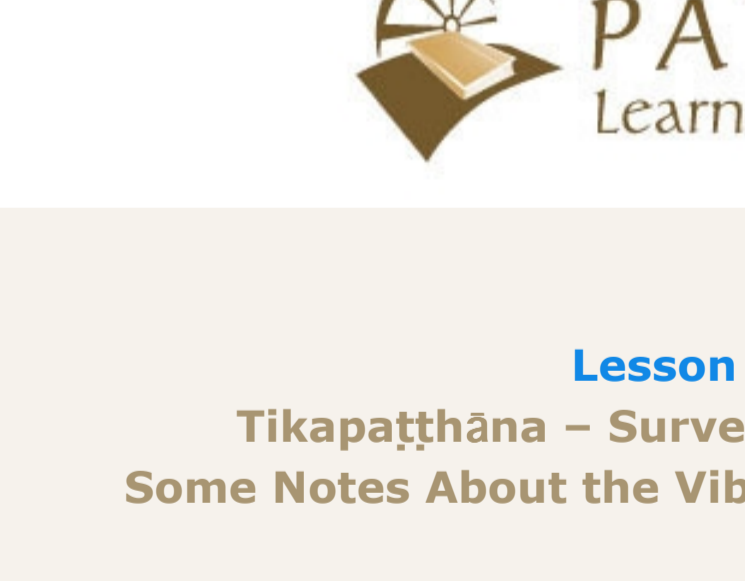
Pariyatti Presents...

In the [Pariyatti Presents...](#) online events program we host author talks as well as other talks, interviews, and lectures with guests from all over the world. The program is set up to learn from the authors about their works and writing processes, and explore a wide range of topics—from Vipassana meditation and its implications in daily life, to the Tipiṭaka, the Pāli language, pilgrimages, and other topics related to the practice and theory of the Buddha's teachings. Although presenters may share their thoughts on different topics, the goal is the same—that all of these offerings serve as inspiration to help support those walking on the path of Dhamma.

2025 opened with [A Virtual Tour of Dhamma Sites](#) by Dr. Hamir Ganla in January; from May to November Vipassana teacher, retired psychiatrist, and author Dr. Paul R. Fleischman joined us no less than six times on Zoom, for a series of interviews related to his 2024 work entitled [The Power of Small Changes: Vipassana Meditation Through the Lens of Biology, Psychology, and Culture](#).

Make sure watch the event recordings as the series covered interesting and varied topics: The Psychological and Social Wellsprings of Vipassana (Part One), How the Brain and the Body Make Vipassana Possible (Part Two), Building a Sustainable Practice (Part Three), Living as a Meditator in the Confusing, Pressured, and Tumultuous World (Part Four), and The Safety of Meditation (Parts Five & Six).

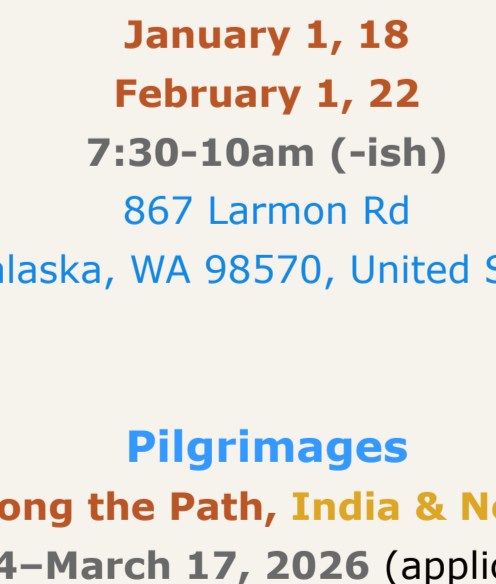
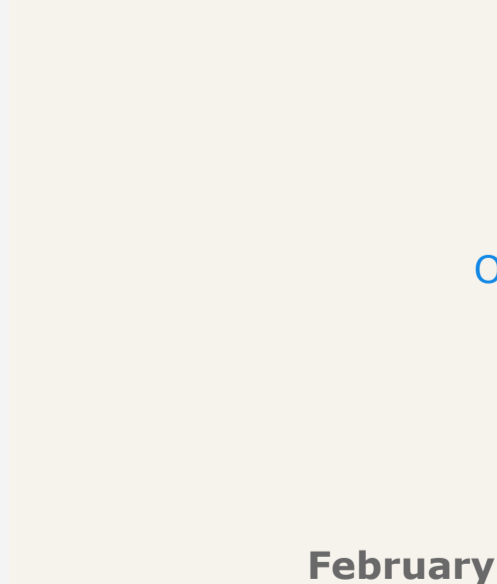

Residential Pāli Workshops

Our Pāli workshop program started in 2012; since then we have facilitated 37 residential workshops: in the USA, in Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Israel, Malaysia, Mexico, Morocco, Poland, and Spain. In 2025 an introductory workshop was held in Spain, and a 15-day introductory workshop in California. The images below were taken during the latter.



Vipassana meditation is an integral part of all our residential Pāli workshops. The daily schedules are similar to those of a 10-day Vipassana course—including three daily group sittings and morning chanting—but with both study and meditation periods throughout the day.

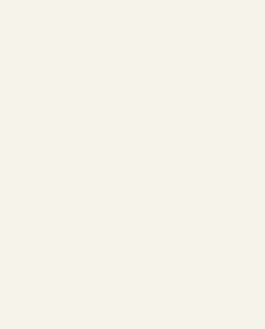
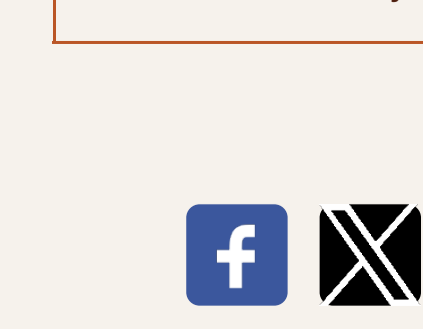
For the coming year, an introductory workshop has been scheduled for **January 30 – February 7** in San Antonio de Pereira, Rionegro, Colombia, at an off-center location.

This workshop will be taught **in the Spanish language** only, by Adriana Patiño, who teaches following a method that emphasizes the content of texts rather than grammar. Participants will first receive an introduction to Pāli grammar and correct pronunciation, and then concentrate most of their time reading, reciting, and understanding the context of the suttas and 10-day course material, such as the formalities and morning chants.

Se ha programado un taller introductorio del 30 de enero al 7 de febrero, 2026 en San Antonio de Pereira, Rionegro, Colombia. Este taller se impartirá únicamente en lengua española, por Adriana Patiño, que enseña siguiendo un método que hace hincapié en el contenido de los textos en lugar de centrarse en la gramática. Los participantes recibirán primero una introducción a la gramática Pāli y a la pronunciación correcta, y después concentrarán la mayor parte de su tiempo en leer, recitar y comprender el contexto de los suttas y el material del curso de 10 días, como las formalidades y los cantos matutinos.

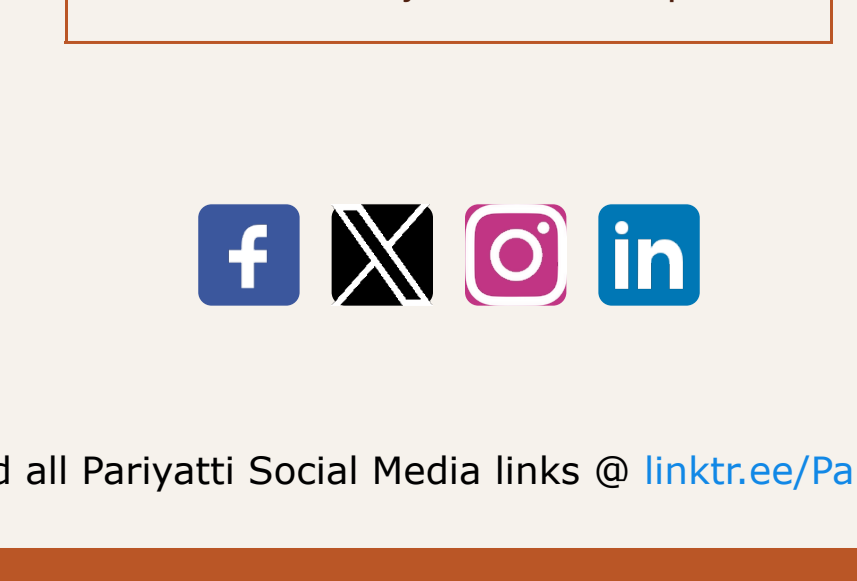

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Lesson 3.10.14.2

**Tikapaṭṭhāna – Survey about the Paṭṭhānapāli
Some Notes About the Vibhaṅgavāro of the Paṭṭhānāro**

The *Vibhaṅgavāro* (investigation chapter) presents the seventh chapter of the Tikapaṭṭhāna. With the long and more detailed *Paṭṭhānāvāro*, the section on enquiries or questions concludes with comprehensible replies. Emphasis here is given to show how conditioned phenomena are related, caused or brought about by conditioning states. The replies that are provided portray a more comprehensive and intelligible description than most previous chapters, that only state conceptual possible occurrences. The answers in the *Paṭṭhānāvāro* are less abstract and offer some illustrations and examples, so the reader can more easily pursue the relation.

The replies refer to questions like 'what effects meritorious acts can produce' or whether 'unwholesome actions always harvest unwholesome results.' Thus, for example, it can be seen that even extremely unwholesome deeds could bring forth wholesome actions in a case where the doer repents, makes a firm determination and tries to counterbalance the kammic effects by performing good and wholesome deeds.
